***Thin Walls* – October 25, 2016 • 12 & 7PM**

Alice Eve Cohen returns in a one-woman play about twelve lives colliding. Set in a century-old New York City residential hotel, once elegant but now crumbling, this darkly humorous and deeply moving play interweaves stories of the building's long-term residents, its recent arrivals, and its ghosts. Audiences who loved *What I Thought I Knew* will love this one too!



***Thao's Library* – November 22, 2016 • 12 & 7PM**

Coping with a life-altering tragedy that has left her feeling hopeless, Elizabeth comes upon a haunting photograph of Thao, a 25 year-old Vietnamese woman born with life-threatening birth defects as a result of Agent Orange. The photograph propels Elizabeth to rural Vietnam to meet a woman whose indomitable spirit inspires her to build a library. These two unlikely friends are brought together, forging a bond that eventually will change both of their lives forever.



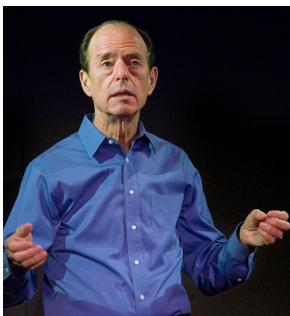
***Rachel Calof - A Memoir with Music* – January 31, 2017 • 12 & 7PM**

Experience the world of Rachel Calof, a Jewish picture bride determined to make a new life as a homesteader. We follow Rachel's touching story as she emigrates from Russia to Devil's Lake, North Dakota in 1894, crossing the ocean to marry a man she has never met. For four years, Rachel and her husband shared a twelve-by-fourteen foot shack with her in-laws, her husband's brother, wife and children, two dozen chickens – and a cow. Rachel gave birth to nine children, all of whom survived. Their descendants are proof of her triumph over adversity.



***Bette Davis Ain't For Sissies* – Feb. 21, 2017 • 12 & 7PM**

It's early evening of the 1939 Academy Awards. Young Bette Davis is nominated for Best Actress in "*Dark Victory*", and the Los Angeles Times leaks the Oscar winners early: "This year Vivian Leigh will take home the Oscar for Best Actress." Newspaper in hand, a bold, defiant and disillusioned Bette decides to leave. Witness the iconic actress's most defining moments as a tenacious young starlet fighting her way to the top, and journey into her battle to win freedom from the grip of Hollywood's studio moguls.



***The Actual Dance* – April 18, 2017 • 12 & 7PM**

One of the most beautiful love stories ever told, *The Actual Dance* is a graceful and inspiring journey through the uncharted waters of illness, where the resilience and power of the human heart ultimately persevere. When first noticing his wife at the age of 16, Sam could not predict the profound connection they would share.
